On site, there are a number of Pelco Spectra IV fully functional, day/night cameras mounted on WEC wind down columns and Honeywell dome cameras, mounted internally. The cameras connect to a Fastrace unit with built in recording facility.

The Fastrace unit then provides network connectivity for access by all on site PC workstations and remote connectivity to an off site monitoring facility.

Once the cameras activate, the images start to stream through to the monitoring centre, allowing operators to interrogate the site and assess the risk.

DCS provide a number of different CCTV systems to suit both business and budget requirements and are able to help customers assess the risk to their business, in order, to help achieve the most appropriate solution for their business.

This can range from a simple wireless IP camera system, relaying images via the internet or GSM to remote computing devices to a fully functional 24 hour, remote monitored solution that provides immediate response and physical intervention on site when required.
